- Our aim is to encourage voter registration, emphasize early voting, and get out the vote for **progressive candidates** by partnering with our diverse Beaufort County community.
- Races we are focusing on:
 - Elect Jamie Harrison (D) and defeat Lindsey Graham (R)—Senate seat
 - Re-elect Joe Cunningham (D) who is running against Nancy Mace (R)—House seat (SC-1)
 - **Elect Progressive candidates down the ballot**
 - Win the White House by defeating Trump (R) and electing Joe Biden (D)—Presidency

IT TAKES MONEY TO WIN AN ELECTION— HERE'S HOW YOU CAN HELP

Ways you can help flip the Senate, hold the House, defeat Trump, and elect down-ballot progressives:

1. Give directly to **progressive candidates** to support their campaigns. (Watch for our newsletter with contact/donation information).
2. Give to **Indivisible** to help turn out the vote in Beaufort County.

WITH YOUR HELP, WE INTEND TO FILL THE AIR WITH OUR GET-OUT-THE-VOTE MESSAGES

- **Billboards**—Voter registration billboards running August and September. Then as many billboards as we can purchase for the month of October.
- **Yard signs**—supporting the billboards and including additional messages, to fill our neighborhoods.
- **Digital media**—supporting both billboards and yard signs.
- **Postcards**—VOTE messages.
- **Radio**—We're getting on local radio stations to stress the importance of voting.

OUR GOAL IS:

\$16,000

Billboards--\$10,500 = 5 boards in October, one each in August and September

Yard Signs--\$1,500 = 500 yard signs

Digital Advertising--\$3,000 = 300,000 impressions/hits

Postcards and stamps--\$1,000 = 1200-1500 postcards with postage

TO ENCOURAGE VOTER REGISTRATION, EARLY VOTING, AND ABSENTEE VOTING

- Running August and September
- Will run in many media—billboard, yard signs, postcards, digital media
- Supported by letters to the editor
